



NTSSA Call for Papers

Annual Conference: 6-10 June 2022

Hosted by the “Jesus and the Gospels” Subgroup

Theme: *Orality and memory in the study of Jesus and/or the Gospels*

The “Jesus and the Gospels” subgroup invites papers for presentation at the 2022 Annual Meeting of the New Testament Society of Southern Africa, hosted by the Faculty of Theology at Stellenbosch University during 6-10 June 2022.

The “Jesus and the Gospels” subgroup will give preference to paper proposals that speak to the 2022 conference theme, *Orality and memory in the study of Jesus and/or the Gospels*, but proposals that fall outside this scope will also be considered. Other subgroup leaders may choose to give preference to papers that deal with memory and/or orality, but this is not an expectation of the organising subgroup.

Paper proposals should be 150-200 words long. The deadline to submit paper proposals is Sunday, 10 April 2022. These may be submitted to the following subgroup leaders:
