8.2. Use of surplus funds

This was discussed in the editorial board. 2016 it was decided that 80% of the surplus of Neotestamentica would go to the society. This money has been used to support people attending the conference. Other suggestions have been made e.g., bursaries and library support. An idea was proposed to sponsor masters or doctoral bursaries, but this involved logistics. More discussion is needed on this, and on accountability for this process. Some guiding principles need to be clarified as well as the process to make decisions. The Exec is given the leeway to discuss and consult on this and to come up with proposals. The Scholar Development Fund needs a set amount each year.
